Carrillo's contribution to the performing arts in Australia is outstanding. In addition to a long and distinguished career in acting Carrillo has been General Manager of the Melbourne Theatre Company and Founding Artistic Director of the Playbox Theatre Company (now Malthouse Theatre). During his time as Chairman of Asialink hundreds of Australian artists held residencies throughout Asia.

In recognition of his services to the performing arts Carrillo was awarded an Officer of the Order of Australia and was the first recipient of the Dame Elizabeth Murdoch Culture Leader of the Year Award. He also has been named Victorian of the Year and in 2011 was awarded a green Room Lifetime Achievement Award.

Carrillo has acted in over 40 professional productions and was a familiar face on television in iconic shows such as Homicide, Bellbird, Prisoner, Bluey, Cop Shop, and Lawson's Mates.
